## WELCOME TO MANCHESTER

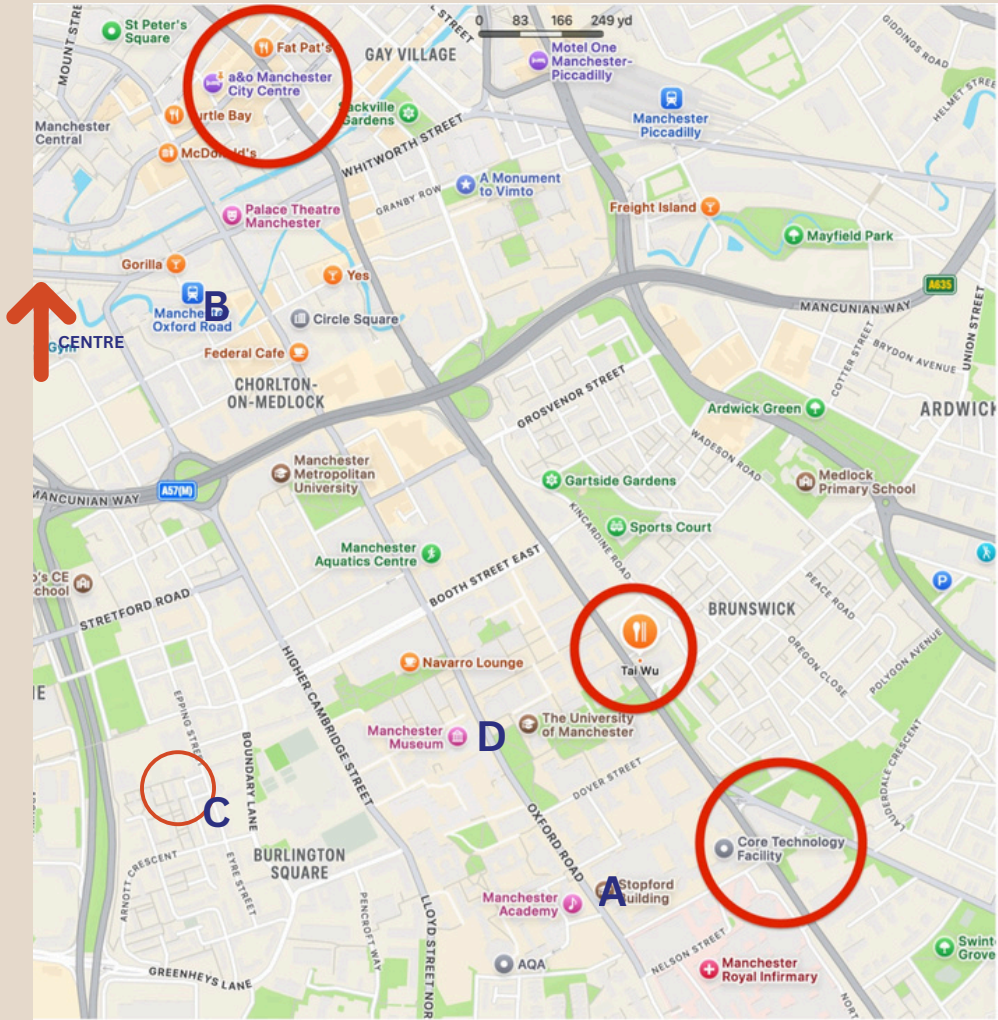
We're delighted you're joining us in Manchester for *Addressing Transport Inequalities in Global South Cities*, and looking forward to an exciting and productive few days.

## ARRIVING IN MANCHESTER

**From Manchester Airport:** The airport is 10 miles from the city centre. You can catch a train from the airport to Manchester Piccadilly or Oxford Road station (approximately 30 minutes travel). Manchester Oxford Road station is about 10 minutes' walk away from A&O Manchester Centre hotel and 25 minutes on foot from the conference venue. Trains from the airport to Manchester city centre run approximately every 20 minutes during the day, starting early in the morning and finishing late in the evening. A single ticket costs less than £7.00.

If you prefer to travel by taxi, there are ranks and dedicated Uber pickup points outside each terminal. Street Cars is the official operator for Manchester Airport. You can book in advance on +44 161 470 0000.

**From Piccadilly Station:** The railway station is about 13 minutes' walk from A&O Manchester Centre hotel or there is a free bus service which runs approximately every 10 minutes. Free Bus 1 or 2 leaves from the station approach; you should get off at St. Peter's Square or Portland Street. You can walk from Piccadilly Station to the conference venue in around 30 minutes.

## TRAVEL IN MANCHESTER

The easiest way to travel from the centre of Manchester to the conference venue is on foot, down Oxford Street / Oxford Road. The walk takes about 20 – 25 minutes.

You can catch a bus (numbers 15, 41, 42, 142, 143, V1) down Oxford Road and get off at either the University or Manchester Royal Infirmary.

For more general travel in Manchester: the city centre is reasonably walkable, or you can catch a tram from St. Peter's Square at the top of Oxford Road (tap in, tap out on the platform).
